GRAPES: 100% Pinot Noir

ALCOHOL: 13°

SOIL: Clay and Limestone, Villefranchian Terrasses

CLIMATE: Temperate Mediterranean. South West exposition.

WINE MAKING

- Parcel Selection
- Harvest by night or early morning (3am to 10am)
- Complete destemming
- Cold pre-fermentation maceration
- Controled fermentation (23° to 28° C)
- Long Maceration (3 to 4 weeks)
- Malolactic fermentation
- Bottled directly after filtering

TASTING NOTES

Light with fresh tannins. Cherry and red berry flavors.
A versatile Pinot Noir that will pair with a wide range of dishes.
